## It goes on!

"My life is full of love and joy" celebrates its resurrection in a new, summery guise: the 'summer ball' – 'under the double-headed eagle' combines the tried-and-tested dance workshop with the advantages of summertime in Vienna: On four mornings (Monday to Friday except Wednesday) we devote ourselves to the unique  $Coq-\grave{a}-l'\^{a}ne$  by E. D. Helmke from his ,Taschenbuch für Tänzer und Tänzerinnen auf das Jahr 1833' (Merseburg) with *Tempo di Marcia - Contredanse - Menuet - Ecossaise - Waltz - Française - Polonaise - Gallop Quadrille*. The Vienna focus is provided by the figures from Franz Anton Roller's *Allemande* for a couple to Joseph Lanner's Dornbacher Ländler op. 9.

On Sunday, July 3rd, 2022 we will meet in the floodplain of the Danube: in the shady guest garden of the 'Goesser Bierinsel' in the Vienna Prater<sup>1</sup>. From 5 p.m. we celebrate our reunion respectively getting to know each other with refreshments and of course dancing (if the weather is nice, bring suitable shoes for gravel!). The 77A bus in the direction of Lusthaus has its terminus directly opposite this restaurant and can be reached by underground lines U3 (Schlachthausgasse) or U2 (Stadion and Donaumarina)<sup>2</sup>. Before that, walk around the nearby Lusthaus<sup>3</sup>. You can see and hear horses and carriages all around.

The dance lessons take place in the University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna at Anton-von-Webern-Platz 1, room M0101 1030 Vienna; on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and

Friday from 9.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. There is a canteen on campus as well as large green areas and seating for picnics.

We spend Tuesday evening in Dornbach, where not only aristocratic families used to escape from the heat and the hustle and bustle of the city. Joseph Lanner paid homage to this former summer resort of the Viennese in his Dornbacher Ländler. From 1865, the first horse-drawn tramway, the "Glöckerlbahn", ran here from the Schottentor to Hernals. The District Museum of Hernals offers a treasure trove of Viennese music by the brothers Johann and Josef Schrammel, among others, where we will receive a competent introduction at 4.30 p.m. Afterwards, a Viennese song evening with Rudi Koschelu awaits us in the Buschenschank of St. Peter Abbey in 1170, Rupertusplatz 5 - in accordance with the law of Josef II - with cold dishes and drinks from their own production.

On July 6, 2022, we will travel to Bratislava, the former Hungarian coronation city in 75 minutes downstream on the Danube. The castle and the old town of Bratislava can be reached from the pier with vintage car rides. The high-speed catamaran starts at 8.30 a.m. from Schwedenplatz in Vienna. The tickets must be booked by everyone in good time!!!<sup>4</sup> The significantly cheaper hourly train connection is not just an alternative for those who decide on the spur of the moment. We end the evening with culinary delights on the Viennese Danube beach.

For free afternoons, we recommend, for example, the *Lainzer Tiergarten* with the *Hermes villa*<sup>5</sup>. On Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. there will be a 'Donauinseltanzen' folklore dance on the cobbled square in front of the lighthouse north of the Reichsbrücke on the Donauinsel. (Underground station Donauinsel). From Thursday, the City of Vienna invites you to the 'Wiener Kultursommer'.

On Friday from 5 p.m. we will find a rustic place to dance, to eat and drink and feed the chickens at the 'Grüass Di a Gott Wirt' in the Vienna Woods Biosphere Park in suitable summer clothing or costumes and gravel-friendly shoes<sup>7</sup>.

At our summer ball on Saturday, July 9th at 4 p.m. (arrival from 3 p.m.) our proven dance musicians Veronica and Adolph will play for us in the mirror hall of the 'Bockkeller'<sup>8</sup>. In the shady garden of the former inn, our physical well-being is taken care of with a cold Heurigen buffet.

Guests are very welcome to the summer ball and all other events! You can join in the dancing (numerous waltzes, polkas and gallops as well as called set dances), kibitz or just be there. The dress code is relaxed according to the season and the suburb: historic ball gown, festive dirndl or summer dress.

All destinations (except for Bratislava) can be reached with a Wiener Linien weekly ticket!<sup>9</sup>
