Dear dance friends,

Our next week with dancing at historical sites with all the advantages of Vienna in the summer time will take place from July 2nd to 8th, 2023.

We meet to dance together with refreshments in the shady guest garden of the 'Goesser Bierinsel' in the Vienna Prater on Sunday, July 2nd from 5 p.m.

To prepare for the final ball and the Thé dansant in Sisi's castle, we refresh our Viennese dance repertoire with the spectacular Kör and its powerful Hungarian steps such as Kettös-forgo, Leejtö or Bokázo as a focus as well as Biedermeier polka refinements. Workshop: Monday to Thursday 9.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. in a familiar setting. After that there is time for culture, leisure, socializing and relaxation.

We spend Friday afternoon from 2:00 p.m. in Sisi's "Castle of Dreams", the Hermesvilla, and the surrounding extensive parks with their diverse wildlife population.

There we are inspired by the Empress's personal belongings and family photos, but above all by a bronze statuette of a Hungarian dancing couple, an evidence of Empress Elizabeth's fondness for Hungary. The dance pose is like in the Kör, which was danced at Viennese balls when the villa was built in the 1880s. Carl Haraschin created a version for two couples, which we will also get to know. We celebrate our Thé dansant in the Tilgnersaal on the ground floor and thus bring the Kör back to Sisi's castle!

For the ball we will meet again on Saturday, July 8, 2023 from 3 p.m. (starting at 4 p.m.) in the mirror hall in the Bockkeller, which has proven itself in 2022. There our dance music awaits us led by Veronica.
